

TWO DAY MOSAIC WORKSHOP

WITH ELAINE AND DAVID COGGINS

During this workshop, participants will learn techniques for creating beautiful mosaics suitable for indoor or outdoor use with a variety of different materials, as well as grouting and finishing methods.

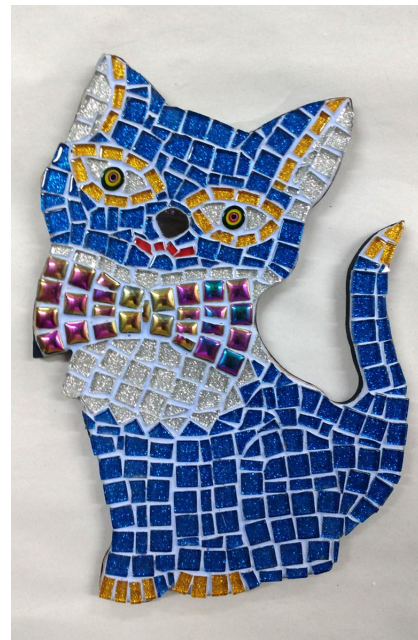
Everyone will complete a small flat mosaic design (10 cm x 10 cm) on 6 mm MDF (supplied pre-sealed at no cost to students) as an introductory training piece. This includes tiles, grouting and finishing.

Methods of fixing mosaic with various adhesives will be discussed, as well as methods of grouting and sealing the mosaic. Different methods of application of the mosaic will be discussed including direct, indirect (reversed), and double indirect (double reversed).

Students will complete a more complex mosaic using materials and designs of their own choice. These projects should be discussed with the tutors prior to the workshop for suitability.

The workshop will be held on 30 and 31 March 2019, at the Artisans' Guild Art Centre in Old Bay Rd, Burpengary. Hours will be 9 am to 4 pm with an hour for lunch (bring your own). Tea and coffee supplied.

Cost for Guild Members will be \$70 for the weekend, non-members will be \$80. Deposit of \$20 required with booking, further information will be supplied on booking. (Minimum numbers will apply, deposit will be refunded if a suitable minimum is not achieved.)
